## The metallurgical group Heneken Group has expanded to a company in South Africa

As announced by the Heneken Group at the beginning of 2023, it has expanded with a new production factory, GFE-MIR. The new addition to the group, with over 100 years of tradition, represents an expansion of Heneken Group's operations in two new countries on the African continent. At the same time, this means an increase of 200 new employees for the group and an increase in assets by €125 million.

In this way, the group leverages the success of recent years and expands its portfolio with 25 new products.

During the year, this is the second significant step for the Heneken Group after the greenfield project in Izmir, Turkey, where the company reports successful operation and produces the first tons of secondary aluminum.
